





#### GUEST LECTURES ORGANIZED:-




☐ Departments of History and Political Science jointly organized an Intra-College Quiz Contest on 13 February, 2021on Social Sciences and Current Affairs.

### कॉलेज के विद्यार्थियों ने ऐतिहासिक धरोहरों का भ्रमण किया

पलवल। गोरुवामी गणेशदत्त सनातन धर्म महाविद्यालय, पलवल के इतिहास एवं राजनीति शास्त्र विभाग के संयुक्त तत्वावधान में विद्यार्थियों के लिए पलवल शहर की पुरातात्विक विरासत (सामग्री) जानने के लिए एक शैक्षिक दौरे का आयोजन किया गया। इसके अंतर्गत सर्वप्रथम विद्यार्थियों को कालेज के गौरवशाली इतिहास के बारे में अवगत कराया गया। तत्पश्चात विद्यार्थियों को 10 अप्रैल 1919 को रोलेट एक्ट के विरोध में गांधी जी की पलवल रेलवे स्टेशन पर प्रथम राजनीतिक गिरफ्तारी की जानकारी और उसकी याद में नेताजी सुभाश चन्द्र बोस के द्वारा स्थापित गांधी आश्रम का अवलोकन कराया। यही पर विद्यार्थियों ने कालेज प्रधान महेन्द्र कालड़ा एवं स्टाफ के साथ चल रहे शांति यज्ञ एवं श्रद्धांजलि सभा में शामिल हुए। इसी के अन्तर्गत विद्यार्थियों ने शेरशाह सूरी द्वारा स्थापित कोस मीनार एवं पंचवटी मंदिर के



दर्शन एवं उसकी ऐतिहासिकता को भी जाना। उपर्युक्त कार्य में डा. राजबीर सिंह, रणवीर सिंह, डा. मीना कुमारी, बलकार सिंह एवं सतीश देशवाल ने विद्यार्थियों का मार्गदर्शन किया।
