Year 2017-2018

1. 1 Orientation Program

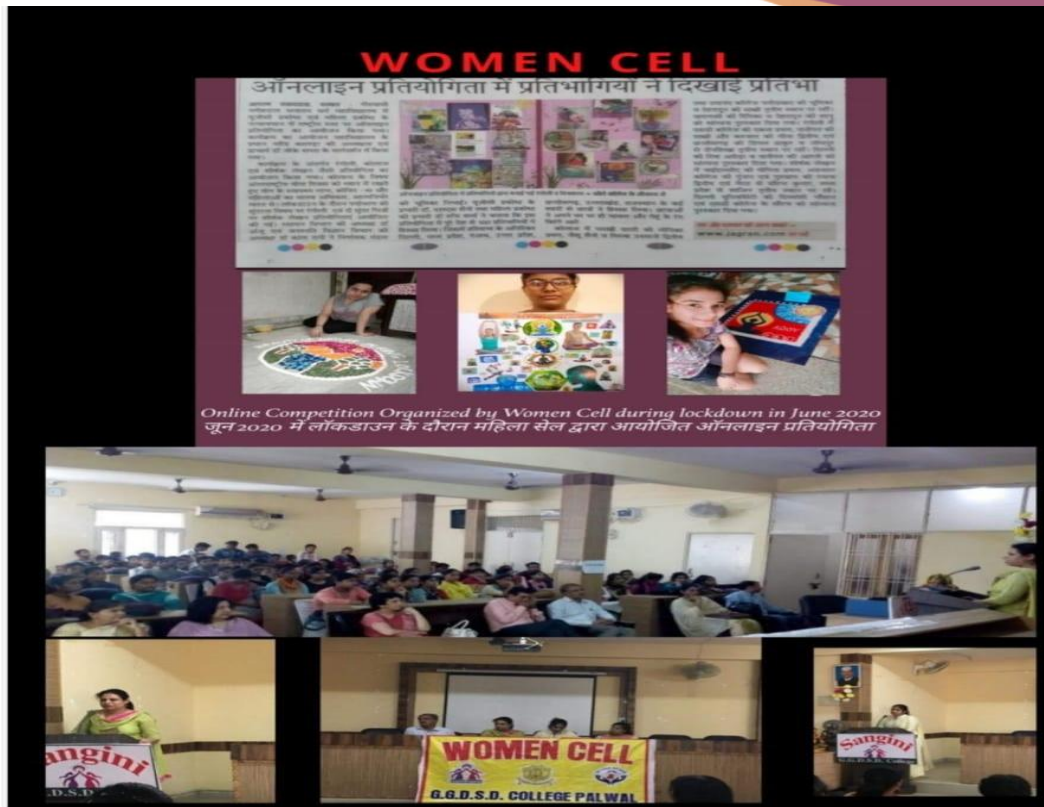

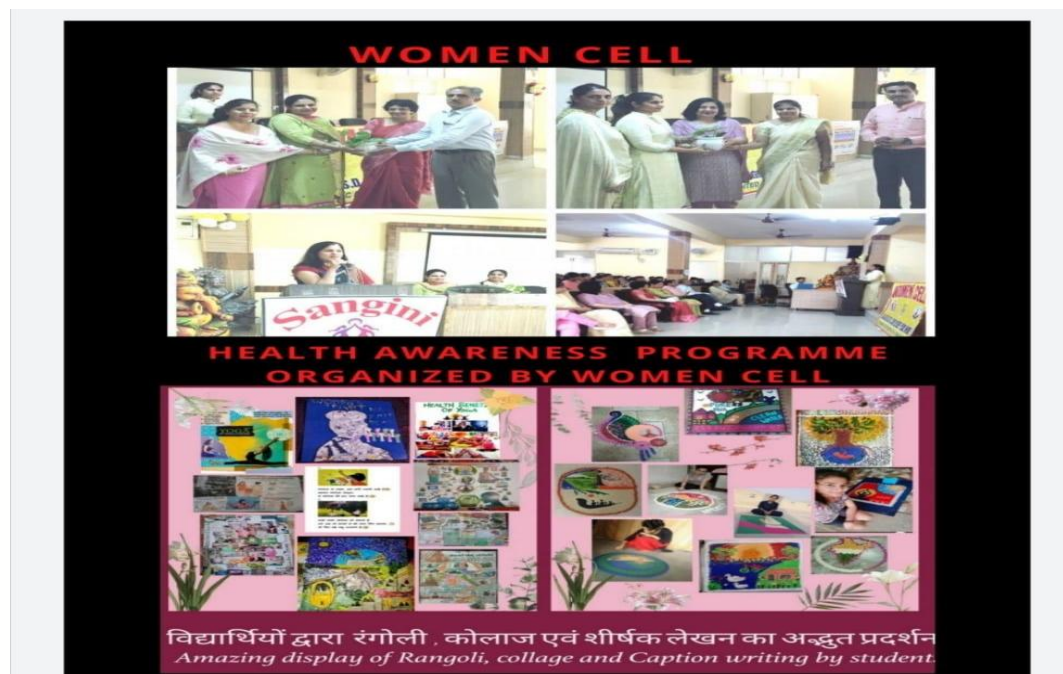
